## Shaft Seals (ctd)


- 5) Slide the seal over the shaft and press it onto the housing bore. Be careful not to damage the seal. **Figure 3**
- 6) Install the seal retaining ring in the housing.Figure 4

## **Charge Check Valves**


- 1) Remove the check valve plug with a 1/4" internal hex wrench. **Figure 5**
- 2) Remove the valve spring and poppet from the pump end cap. **Figure 6**

CAUTION: Do not allow the poppet to fall into the closed loop passages in the end cap.


- 3) Inspect the poppets and mating seats in the end cap for damage or foreign material.
- 4) Lay the pump on its side and reinstall the poppet, spring and plug (O-ring) into the end cap. Be certain the poppet does not fall into the closed loop passage. Torque the plug to 15-20 ft. lbs. Turn the unit over and repeat for the other check valve.
